

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE CALDWELL STREET, HACKFORD ROAD, ISABEL STREET,  
LIBERTY STREET AND MORAT STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable carriageway works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering: -
  - (a) that length of Caldwell Street, which lies between a point 20 metres east of Hackford Road and a point 20 metres west of Hackford Road;
  - (b) that length of Hackford Road which lies:
    - (i) between a point 15 metres north of Caldwell Street and a point 15 metres south of Caldwell Street;
    - (ii) between a point 15 metres north of Isabel Street and a point 15 metres south of Isabel Street;
  - (c) Isabel Street;
  - (d) that length of Liberty Street which lies between a point 15 metres north of Isabel Street and a point 15 metres south-east of Isabel Street;
  - (e) that length of Morat Street which lies between Isabel Street and a point 25 metres north of Isabel Street.
2. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent, as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Order will come into force on 14<sup>th</sup> January 2012 and will continue for 12 months, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. This allows for contingencies as it is anticipated that the works will take about 5 months to complete.
