<p>Two-storey, two-window house of C18 shape but early C19 front. Pinkish brick below, stock brick above. Stucco facade with incised lines, cornice and blocking course. First floor sash windows with delicate glazing bars in near-flush segment headed frames, set in later moulded architraves. DESCRIPTION
<p>Early C19. Short terrace, each two storeys and basement, two windows. Stock brick. Nos 103 and 105 have stuccoed basements and all have stuccoed frieze, cornice and blocking course. Nos 103 and 105 have slate mansards with dormers. Gauged flat brick arches to sash windows with glazing bars. Seven steps to stone terraces in front of four-panel doors with rectangular fanlights in stuccoed panels with cornices (except No 105, stucco lined reveal only). Steps and terraces have graceful wrought iron railings with delicate anthemion patterns. Listing NGR: TQ3042377302</p>

<p>Early C19 appearance. Three storeys and sunk basement, three windows. Originally of yellow brick but largely rebuilt in reddish brick with parapet front. Gauged brick arches to sash windows with glazing bars in stucco-lined reveals, those on ground floor round-headed. DESCRIPTION
<p>Handsome examples of the early-mid C18 town house. Each two storeys, attic and basement, four windows. Brownish-yellow brick with red brick dressings. High pitched tiled roof with two dormers, sash windows with glazing bars, classical cornices and flat, leaded tops. Moulded and modillion wood eaves cornice. Early C19 sash windows with delicate glazing bars in near-flush moulded wood architraves all under finely gauged brick arches, cut and curved on first floor, supporting moulded string on ground floor. No 41 has door of six fielded panels; other doors altered; all under rectangular fanlights, Nos 41 and 43 paired. Doors, set in panels of stucco banded rustication, have Doric entablature door-cases (that of No 39 a restoration) with large segmental pediments over. GLC blue plaque on No 43: JOHN FRANCIS BENTLEY 1839-1902 ARCHITECT LIVED HERE. Listing NGR: TQ2924175545</p>

<p>Nos 39 and 41 have early C19 brick walls with flat stone top and a cast-iron overthrow with lamp holder to gateway of No 39. No 43 has original brick wall with curved stone coping; and there is a similar dividing wall ramped up to house between front doors of Nos 41 and 43. Tall wrought iron railings on wall and a tall single wrought iron gate with ornamental side panels, pier on dividing wall and ornamental overthrow.</p> <p>Listing NGR: TQ2922875549</p>

<p>Late C18 with alterations, probably originally one house. Three storeys and attic, three windows. Stock brick with parapet coping rebuilt in brick and tile. Slated. mansard roof with dormers. Tripartite side windows. All windows sashes with glazing bars under flat gauged brick arches. Ground floor completely altered, with modern shop front at left, tiling in centre; carriage doors under beam at right perhaps original; door of six fielded panels to No 8, just left of centre. <p>Circa 1800, but may have older core. Three-storeys and basement, three windows. Stock brick with stone-coped parapet and slated roof with end chimneys. Gauged flat brick arches to sash windows with glazing bars in near-flush box frames. Three bay left return has entrance up five steps to half glazed door, with classical surround including pilasters with feathery capitals, cornice and patterned radial fanlight, in stucco lined reveal under round gauged brick arch with key and impost blocks; above this an elliptical headed window in moulded wood architrave with keystone to gauged brick arch, and a lunette with radial glazing over. <p>Early C19 house of three storeys, two windows; now two dwellings. Stock brick with stucco frieze and cornice, stone-coped brick parapet. Gauged flat brick arches to sash windows with glazing bars in stucco lined reveals. Ground floor window tripartite under wide elliptical gauged brick arch.
