Rose and Bronze Plaque

The rose beds are situated in the Garden of Remembrance.

A variety of roses are planted in various beds and are available for dedication in memory of one or more members of the family. The dedication includes a bronze memorial plaque suitably inscribed with a message, and also includes the day to day maintenance of the rose.

You may select the position of your rose from those available, to ensure the perfect surroundings in which to remember your loved ones.

6. Only one plaque is permitted per rose.
