The Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004**

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Lambeth adopted its Residential Alterations and Extensions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on the 28th of April 2008.

The Residential Alterations and Extensions SPD contains a wide range of guidance relating to alterations and extensions to residential dwellings within the Borough. It will provide applicants with a clearer understanding of the Council's requirements, with the aim of improving the quality of proposals and the consistency and speed of decisions, whilst protecting both residential amenity and townscape quality.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application must be made promptly and no later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted as stated above.
