d. Boz to attend Voluntary action council on 16th regarding the Local Area Agreement. *Boz submitted points to Ian Banner.*

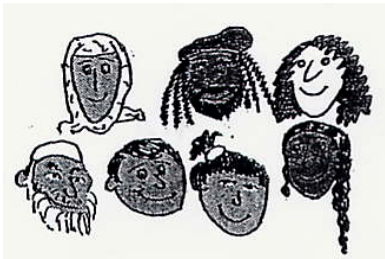
e. Cornwall report. Lambeth to take finding and ideas from report into account.

Then we had a deserved break!

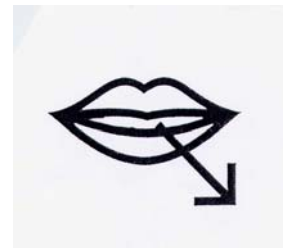
The second session of Work groups looked at:

All the groups highlighted that communication is an important factor in the Partnership Boards work and making services better.

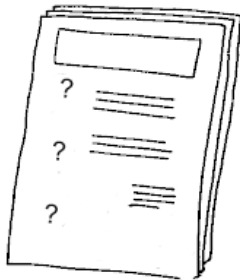


After all the information is put together it needs to be decided who will make these things actually happen.

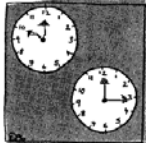
SUPPORTING FAMILY CARERS
