



# **TOWN CENTRE EDUCATION PROFILES**

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## INTRODUCTION

This document provides a profile of education data for each town centre area in Lambeth. The main aim of the education profiles are to focus attention on individual town centre issues. The five town centres have been defined by Lambeth council and are as follows:

- Brixton
- Clapham & Stockwell
- Norwood
- Streatham
- North Lambeth

Each profile includes characteristics of the school population in terms of:

- Ethnicity
- Fluency in English
- Main language spoken
- Free school meal eligibility
- SEN status
- Attendance rates
- Attainment outcomes at key stages 1,2, and GCSE

Census data from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) has also been presented here, showing the overall resident population by age and gender, together with a range of social characteristics for each town centre area.

In Lambeth, we are committed to making ourselves a questioning and learning authority. We hope this document will enable council members, schools and LA services to make better judgements about their own performance and to identify key areas for improvement.

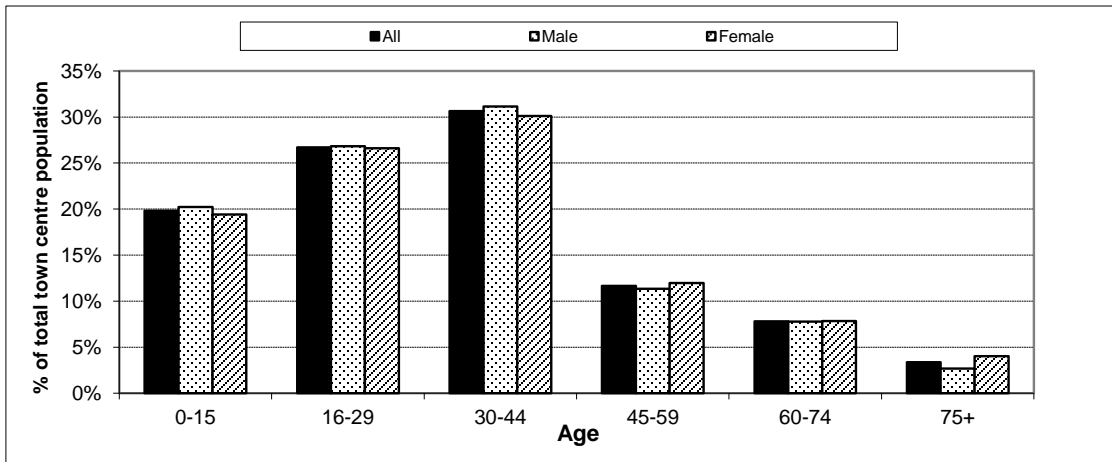

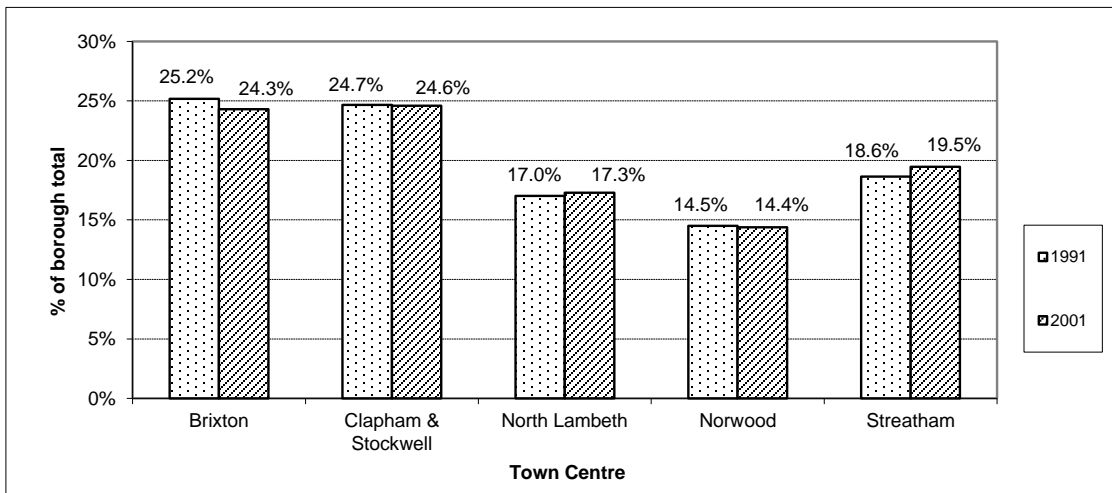

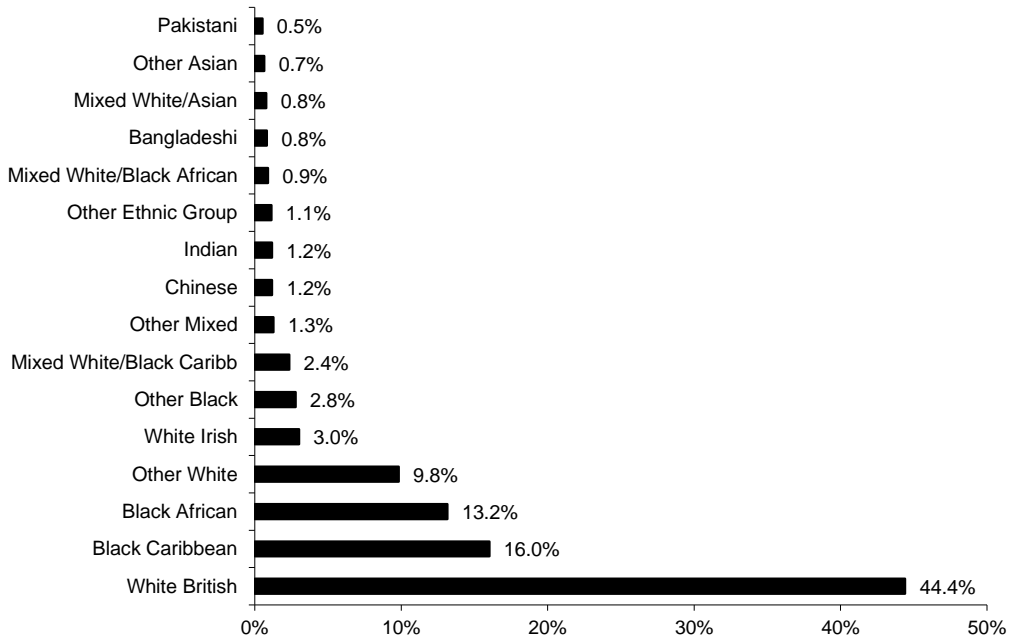

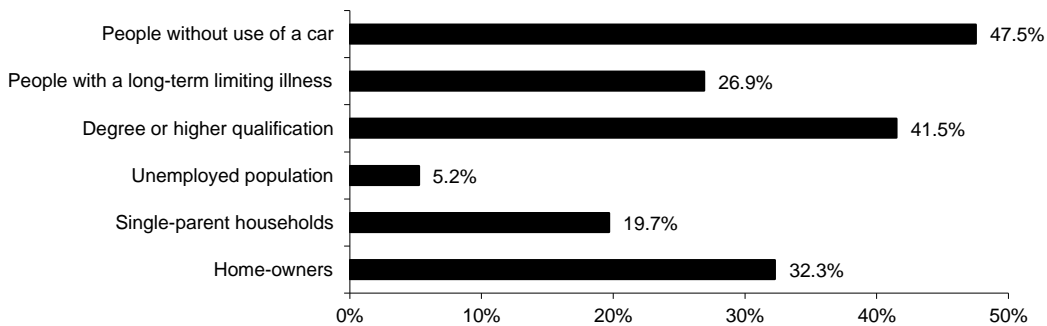

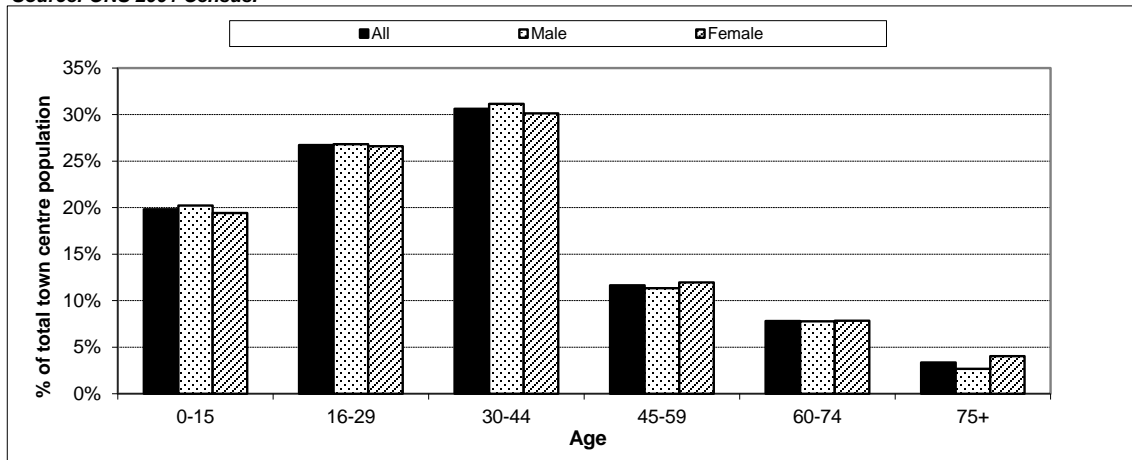

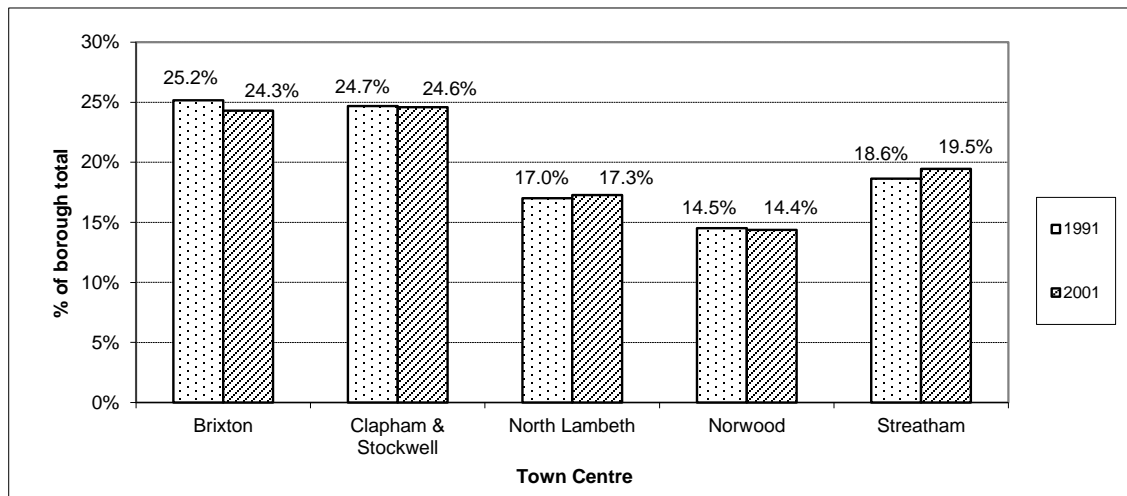

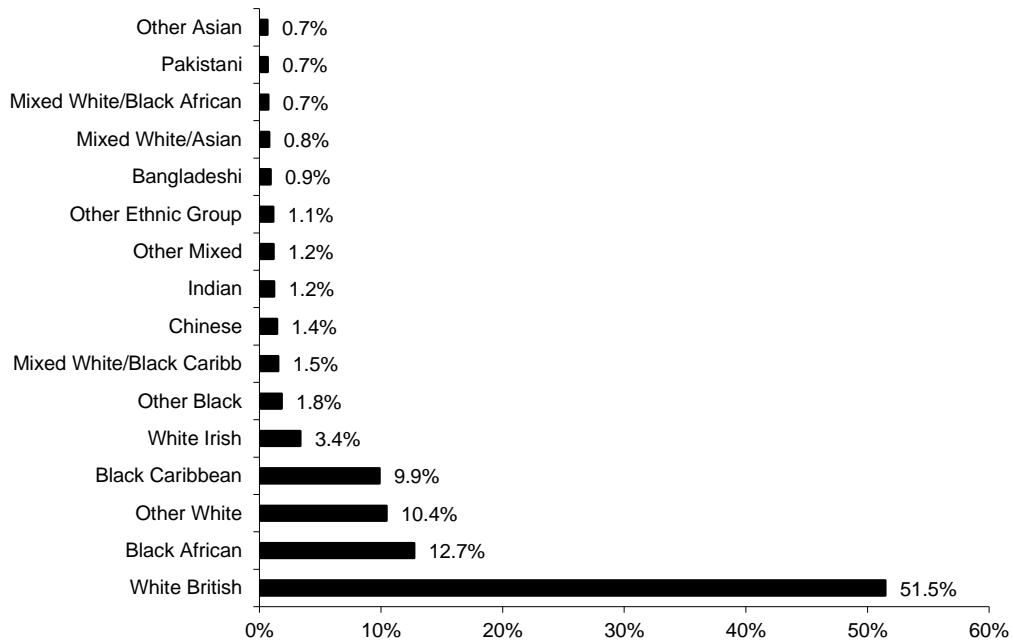

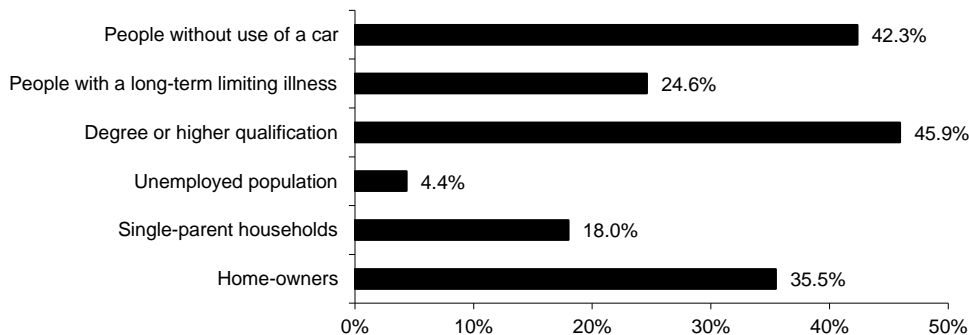

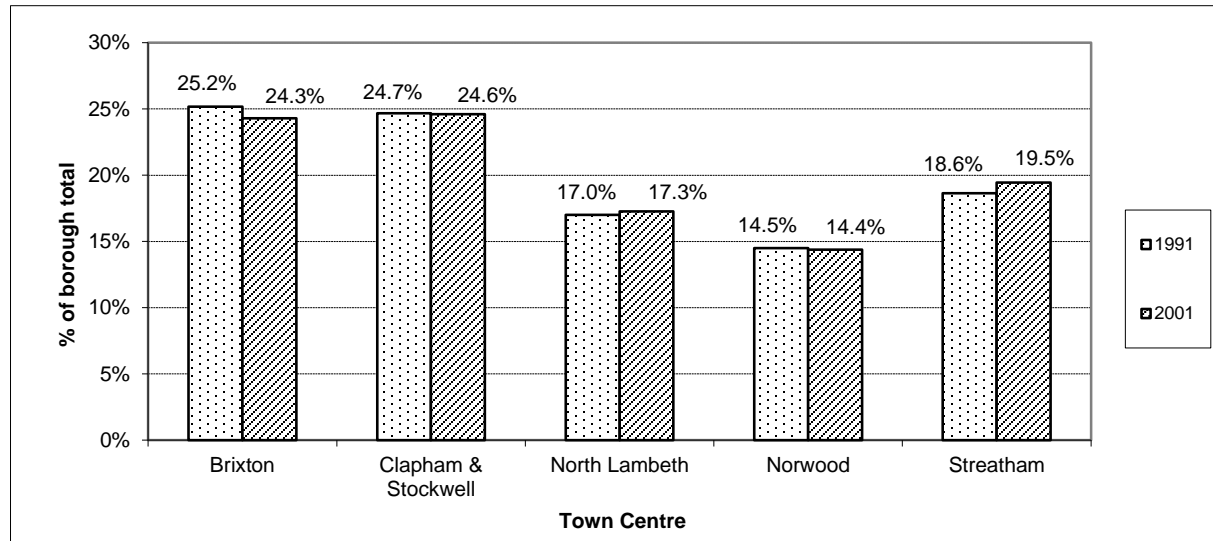

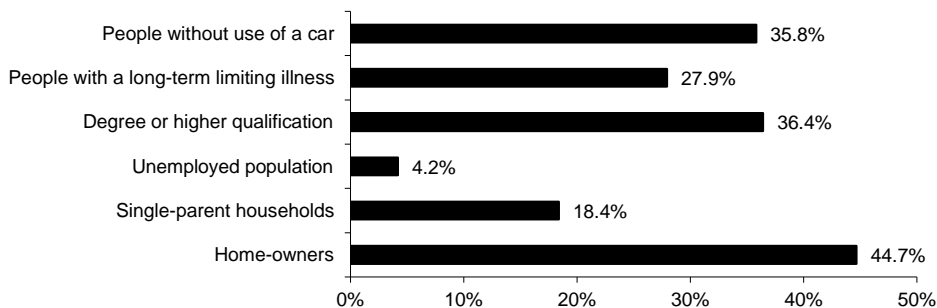

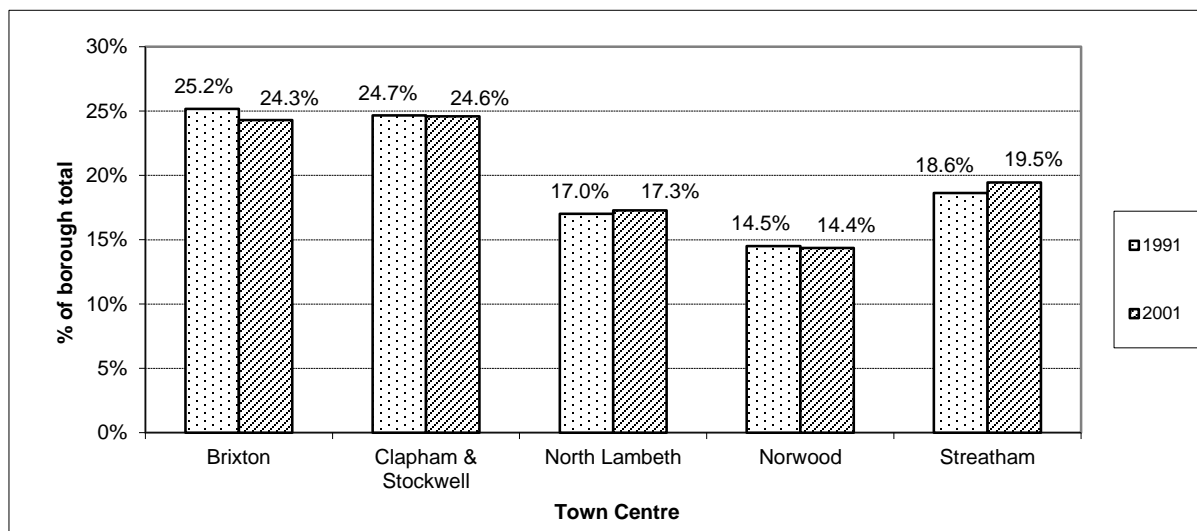

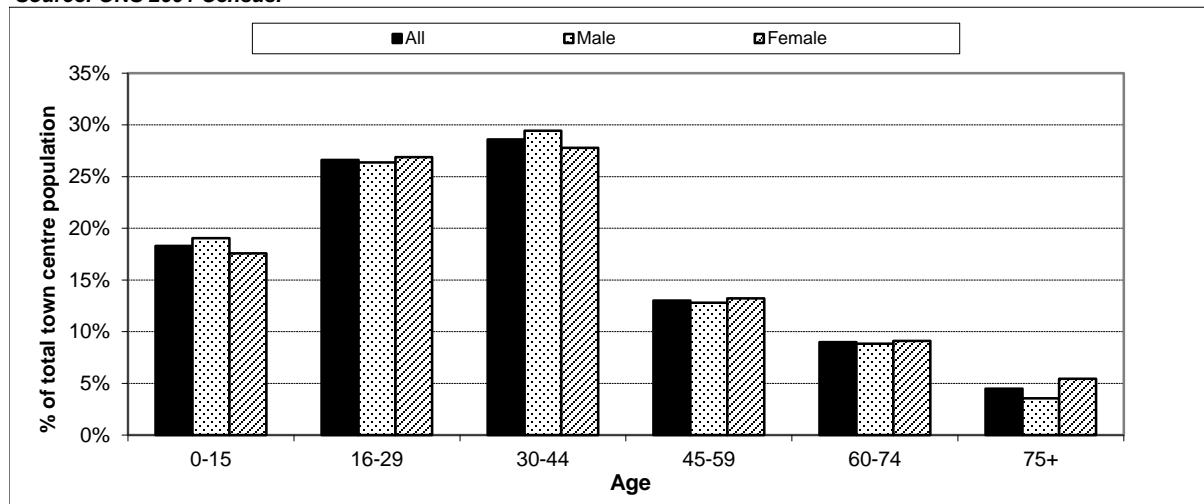

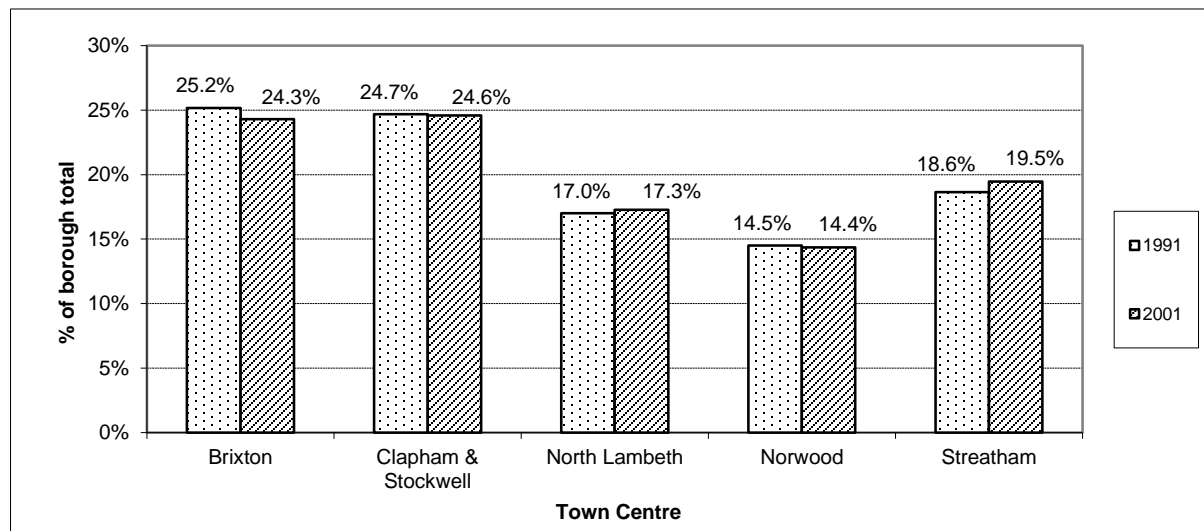

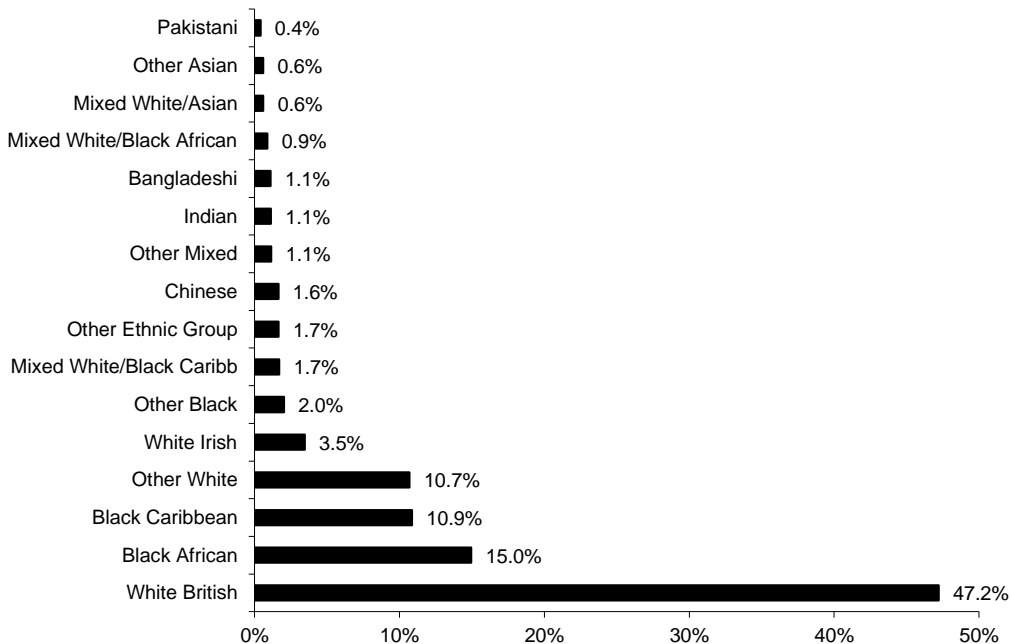

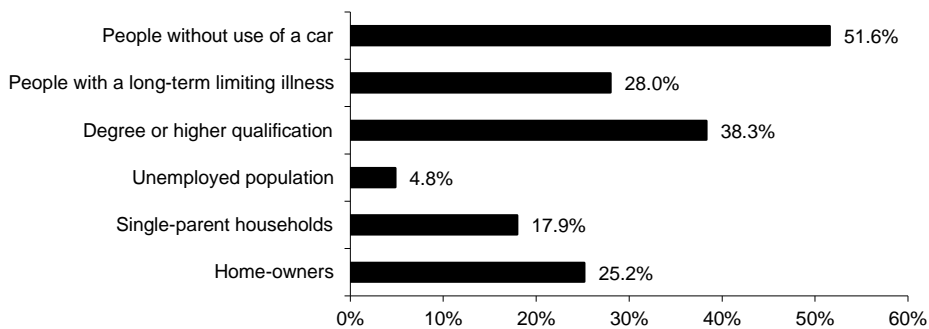
