

# Proposed Waiting Restrictions

## Streatham Hill East Area

Implementation

### Dear Resident/Business

The purpose of this leaflet is to let you know the outcome of the statutory consultation carried out in February/ March 2018, and to inform you of the Council's decision on the proposed parking measures throughout the Streatham Hill area. All representations received along with officers' recommendations were presented in a report to be considered by the Council.

After careful consideration a decision has been made to proceed with the implementation of the proposed 'G' Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ); the extension to the proposed 'R' CPZ and the introduction of double yellow line waiting restrictions at specific locations. Please note, the Council received three separate petitions requesting that this area be re-consulted on proposals to introduce a CPZ. These petitions have been analysed and are currently under consideration. Once a decision has been taken, you will be informed accordingly.

### What Happens Next

The final Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), which allow the restrictions to be implemented and administered, will be published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper (Lambeth Weekender) shortly. Notices will also be placed on lamp columns in the affected area.

Finally, we would like to thank everyone for their participation and feedback during the consultation process.

### Implementation Works

The lining works for your area will be carried out by our contractor CVU (Colas Volker Highways URS) on behalf of the Council. It is anticipated that the works for the entire area, which includes the new Streatham Hill West Zone 'G' and the Thornton Zone 'R' extension will start the week commencing **28 August 2018** for a period of 4 weeks. The works for your area should take 5 - 7 working days to complete, weather permitting.

Works will generally be carried out Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm, some weekend works may take place if necessary. Warning notices and 'No Parking' cones will be placed in your road 12 – 48hrs prior to work being undertaken to indicate the areas/roads where parking will be prohibited.

Whilst work is being undertaken in your street, please avoid parking where the "No Parking" cones have been put in place. This will allow time for the lining works to proceed efficiently, and a smooth transition of the works without delays. In order for the works to be carried out as quickly as possible, temporary parking restrictions will be introduced to prevent vehicles from obstructing the work. Offending vehicles run the risk of receiving a fine and possible relocation.

The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and the disruption that this work may cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused whilst the works are being carried out.
