MAKING USE OF RAISEonline

Course Overview:

RAISEonline plays an important role in the process of school self-evaluation and linked with accountability agenda as the data set is used by agencies such as OFSTED for school inspections, DfE and school improvement partners (SIP) to challenge school's performance. The aim of the course is to provide schools with training and support on how to access RAISEonline data on line and understand the data analysis. The training sessions will cover:

- Getting started logging on to RAISE; quick links to reports; navigation tabs; the 'Full Report'; other functions e.g. the administration setup.
- Reports & Analysis the types of analysis available; interacting with reports and charts e.g. filtering data, saving & exporting your results.
- Understanding the data interpreting value-added scores (an explanation of significance tests; confidence intervals & shrinkage factors); average point scores and trends in attainment.

Target Audience: The target audience is primary headteachers and senior teachers who are new to using RAISEonline. Each of the training sessions takes approximately 3 hours. School will use their own data.

Course Outcomes: By the end of the course participants will be able to understand the features of RAISEonline data and its implications for OfSTED inspection and school self-evaluation.
