ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – NORWOOD HIGH STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge repair works to be carried out by Network Rail, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Norwood High Street, which lies between Hannen Road and Cotswold Street.
2. The alternative route for affected vehicles would be via: (a) for heavy commercial vehicles (HGVs) – Norwood Road, Lancaster Avenue, Thurlow Park Road, Croxted Road, South Croxted Road, Alleyn Road, Dulwich Wood Park, College Road, Crystal Palace Parade, Church Road, Westow Street, Central Hill, Crown Dale and Knights Hill; and (b) for non-heavy commercial vehicles – Auckland Hill, Gipsy Road and Norwood High Street.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 25th July 2022 for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed overnight, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
