Dear Resident/Business

The purpose of this leaflet is to let you know the outcome of the statutory consultation carried out in March/April 2022 on the proposed extension of the Clapham (Zone L) Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) into The Paddocks.

All representations received during the statutory consultation were supportive of the proposals, although some comments were received in relation to maintenance of road surfacing, replacement of existing street furniture, setting out individual bays and introduction of yellow lines. These are outside the scope of this particular proposal.

A report considering these comments were presented to the council and a decision was made to proceed with the proposals to extend the Zone L CPZ as Permit Holder Only Past this Point (POPTP) parking into The Paddocks. What happens next?

The Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), which allow this CPZ extension have been made and were published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper (South London Press) on Friday 23 September 2022. Notices were also placed on lamp columns in the area.

Implementation works

The lining and signing works will be carried out by our contractor **Ringway** on behalf of the Council. It is anticipated that the works will start towards the end of the week commencing **17 October 2022** and will take no longer than one week to complete.

The CPZ extension will be operational from **Monday 31 October 2022** and for the first two weeks there will be a period of 'soft enforcement' through the issue of warning notices only.

Do I have to pay to park?

Residents of Nos. 32–61 Clapham Common South Side, are already eligible to purchase permits to park in roads within the adjacent Zone L Clapham CPZ.

Any resident living in or business located in The Paddocks CPZ extension, who owns a car and wants to park during the hours of control 9am – 6pm Monday to Friday, will need a parking permit.

If you already have a Zone L permit to park in the existing CPZ you do not need to purchase a new permit. If you park your vehicle off street on your driveway/private property you would also not require a parking permit.

Residents will also be able to buy visitor vouchers for their guests to be able to park in the PHOPTP parking area, or trader vouchers so that works (such as renovations or landscaping) can be done at their properties

How do I apply for a parking permit/vouchers?
