## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - BERNAY'S GROVE AND BRIGHTON TERRACE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable SGN to carry out gas main disconnection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily:-
  - (a) impose a one-way system in that length of Brighton Terrace which lies between Brixton Road and Bernay's Grove in westerly direction (towards Bernay's Grove);
  - (b) ban all vehicles proceeding in Bernay's Grove from turning left into Brighton Terrace.
- 2. An alternative route for affected vehicles will be available via Brighton Terrace, Trinity Gardens, Acre Lane and Brixton Road.
- 3. The Order will come into force on 21st January 2023 and continue for 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
