TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS ELLORA ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily:
 - (a) ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of loading / unloading, in Ellora Road, both sides, between the common boundary of Nos. 3 and 5 Ellora Road and the common boundary of Nos. 13 and 15 Ellora Road; and
 - (b) ban pedestrians from entering that section of the north-eastern footway of Ellora Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 5 and 7 Ellora Road and the common boundary of Nos. 11 and 13 Ellora Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians would be provided via the south-western footway of Ellora Road.
- 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 12th December 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 12th December 2022 and 16th December 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
