TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLASSHOUSE WALK

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out new supply connection works safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Glasshouse Walk which lies between Albert Embankment and the western kerb-line of Goding Street.
- 2 The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
- 3. Alternative routes will be available:
 - (a) for all vehicles via Tyers Street, Black Prince Road, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road and Albert Embankment; and
 - (b) for vehicles of height 13'-9" or lower, via Tyers Street, Black Prince Road and Albert Embankment.
- 4. The Order will come into force on 23rd January 2023 and continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
