TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE PALFREY PLACE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out new connection works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that legth of Palfrey Place which lies between Fentiman Road and No. 35 Palfrey Place (approximately 33 metres).
- 2. An alternative route will be available for affected vehicles via Richborne Terrace, Carroun Road and Fentiman Road.
- 3. Whenever the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1 above apply, the one-way system in that length of Palfrey Place which lies between Fentiman Road and Richborne Terrace will be suspended to allow access and egress to properties in that length of Palfrey Place, as far as the works allow it.
- 4. The ban and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5. The Order will come into force on 18th January 2023 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
