ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AND SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEMS – ABERFOYLE ROAD AND CARNFORTH ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily: -
- (a) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in that length of Aberfoyle Road which lies between Carnforth Road and the party wall of Nos. 48 and 50 Aberfoyle Road;
- (b) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in that length of Carnforth Road which lies between Aberfoyle Road and the south-western property boundary of No. 27 Carnforth Road;
- (c) suspend the Order imposing a one-way system in that length of Aberfoyle which lies between Broadview Road and the party wall of Nos. 48 and 50 Aberfoyle Road; and
- (d) suspend the Order imposing a one-way system in that length of Carnforth Road which lies between Broadview Road and the north-eastern property boundary of No. 27 Carnforth Road.
- 2. The alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Abercairn Road, Broadview Road and Carnforth Road and vice versa.
- 3. The bans and suspension of one-ways would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 9th January 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed within 3 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
