ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - DORCHESTER DRIVE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication upgrade works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering in that length of Dorchester Drive which lies between the northeastern property boundary of No.2 Dorchester Drive and the south-western property boundary of No.4 Dorchester Drive; and
 - (b) ban pedestrians from entering that length of the south-eastern footway which lies between the north-eastern arm of the un-named access road to Tudor Stacks and the south-western arm of the unnamed access road to Tudor Stacks.
- 2. The alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Poplar Walk and Brantwood Road and vice versa. Pedestrians would be diverted to the north-western footway.
- 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 9th January 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed on the following dates: 9th January 2023 for 1 day and 23rd January 2023 for 1 day; but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during these times then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
