ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - FARMHOUSE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable repair and maintenance works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in that length of Farmhouse Road which lies between Larbert Road and the party wall of No. 13 Farmhouse Road and No. 15 Farmhouse Road:
 - (b) ban pedestrians from entering that length of the north-eastern footway of that length of Farmhouse Road as specified in sub-paragraph 1(a) above.
- 2. The alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Larbert Road, Meadfoot Road and Granton Road and vice versa. Pedestrians would be diverted to the south-western footway.
- 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 9th January 2023 for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be completed between 9th January 2023 and 12th January 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during these times then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 6 months.
