## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - HITHERFIELD ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable leak detection and other associated water works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Hitherfield Road which lies between Leigham Vale and the party wall of Nos. 2 and 4 Hitherfield Road.
- 2. The alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via: Leigham Vale, Stockfield Road, Mount Nod Road, Hitherfield and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2023 for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will only have effect on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2023 for 1 day and 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023 for 3 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times within the maximum period of 12 months.
