ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS ULLSWATER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Southern Gas Networks to carry out repair works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Ullswater Road which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Norwood Road and the north-eastern kerb-line of Ulverstone Road.
2. Alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via (a) Ulverstone Road, Harpenden Road and Norwood Road; and (b) Norwood Road, York Hill and Harpenden Road.
3. The above temporary traffic restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order will come into force on 23rd January 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (allowing for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
