ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - ALBERT SQUARE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable public realm improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Albert Square, the north-west to south-east arm, which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Albert Square, the south-west to north-east arm and the north-western kerb-line of Hampson Way.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would not be required.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 20th February 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be take place between 20th February 2023 and 13th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 3 months.
