**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AND TEMPORARY PARKING,**

**STOPPING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS BELVEDERE ROAD IN CONNECTION WITH**

**THE ROYAL FESTIVAL HALL BAFTA AWARDS EVENT**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
  - (i) ban vehicles from entering and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in:-
    - (a) that length of **Belvedere Road**, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Concert Hall Approach and Upper Ground;
    - (b) that length of **Upper Ground**, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Cornwall Road and Belvedere Road;
    - (c) **the slip road linking Waterloo Road with Belvedere Road** (the down ramp), the whole length.
  - (ii) ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in that length of **Belvedere Road** which lies on the south-east side, between Concert Hall Approach and Chicheley Street (including the parking places).
2. The bans are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public caused by an increase in pedestrian and vehicular traffic and parked vehicles due to the Bafta Awards event taking place at the Royal Festival Hall.
3. The road closures and waiting restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs and vehicles belonging to residents and businesses of the roads concerned would be allowed access to properties.
4. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles affected by the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1(i) above via (a) Concert Hall Approach, Waterloo Road (the Imax roundabout), Stamford Street and Cornwall Road; and (b) Cornwall Road, Stamford Street, Waterloo Road (the Imax roundabout), York Road, Chicheley Street and vice versa.
5. The Order would come into force on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 days.
