## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - HAYTER ROAD**

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable new water service works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Hayter Road, which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Brixton Hill and the north-western side of No. 2 Hayter Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Hayter Road, Beverstone Road, Sudbourne Road and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and 24<sup>th</sup> February 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
