TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - LANSDOWNE HILL & CHESTNUT ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable UK Power Networks duct installation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of:
 - (i) Lansdowne Hill, between the western kerb-line of Norwood Road and a point 20 metres west of that kerb-line, adjacent to No. 362 Norwood Road; and
 - (ii) Chestnut Road, between the eastern kerb-line of Norwood Road and a point 10 metres east of that kerb-line, adjacent to No. 541 Norwood Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via (i) Lansdowne Hill, Royal Circus, York Hill and Norwood Road; and (ii) Norwood Road, Robson Road and Chestnut Road; and (iii) Norwood Road, Chatsworth Way, Idmiston Road, Ardlui Road and Chestnut Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 11th February 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 11th February 2023 and 19th February 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
