ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – RAILTON ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable footway buildouts works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of:

- (i) Railton Road, which lies between the south-eastern boundary of No. 90 Kellett Road and the south-eastern kerb-line of Kellett Road; and
- (ii) Atlantic Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 82 and 84/86 Atlantic Road and the north-western kerb-line of Kellett Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Atlantic Road, Saltoun Road, Rattray Road and Barnwell Road, and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 27th February 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between the 27th February 2023 and the 24th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
