ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - PALACE ROAD AND HILLSIDE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water sewer repair and new electrical supply works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of Loading / unloading, in that section of:
 - (a) Palace Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 51 and 53 Palace Road and the common boundary of Nos. 55 and 57 Palace Road; and
 - (b) Hillside Road, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Palace Road and the north-eastern boundary of No. 6 Hillside Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would not be required.
- 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 6th March 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works on Palace Road would take place between 6th March 2023 and 17th March 2023, and the works on Hillside Road would take place between 11th April 2023 and 13th April 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 3 months.
