ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE VIRGIL STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable sewer repair works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Virgil Street which lies between Hercules Road and the south-eastern side of the railway bridge over Virgil Street (approximately 33 metres).
2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via: Hercules Road, Cosser Street, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road, Hercules Road and Carlisle Lane.
3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies the order that imposes:-
 - (a) the one-way system in Virgil Street; and
 - (b) the ban on vehicles proceeding in Carlisle Lane from entering Virgil Street, would be suspended.
4. The ban and suspensions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order would come into force on 20th February 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on the 20th and 21st February 2023; but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
