## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

## **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CLAYLANDS ROAD**

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable public realm improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of:
  - (i) Claylands Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 14 and 16 Claylands Road and the north-western kerb-line of Clapham Road;
  - (ii) Palfrey Place, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Claylands Road and the common boundary of No. 9 Claylands Road and No. 1 Palfrey Place; and
  - (iii) Claylands Place, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Claylands Road and a point 9 metres north-east of that kerb-line.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Clapham Road, Elias Place, Handforth Road, Brixton Road, Prima Road, Palfrey Place and Trigon Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be take place between 11<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 3 months.
