**PROPOSED REMOVAL OF DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES IN FERNDALE ROAD**

*[NOTE: This Notice is about the proposed removal of certain disabled persons' parking places where they are no longer required in Ferndale Road and the introduction of new parking spaces or "at any time" waiting restrictions (shown as double yellow lines) where the disabled persons' parking places are removed. Objections or other comments may be made – see paragraph 6.]*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth proposes to make The Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 202\* and The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. \*) Order 202\* under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be, in Ferndale Road, to:

(a) remove the disabled persons parking places and replace with a residents parking place outside:

- (i) No. 2;
- (ii) No. 8;
- (iii) No. 12;
- (iv) No. 11;
- (v) No. 62; and
- (vi) No. 78;

(b) remove the disabled persons parking places and replace with "at any time" waiting restrictions, shown on the carriageway as double yellow lines outside:

- (i) No. 40;
- (ii) No. 42;
- (iii) Nos. 63 and 65; and
- (iv) No. 92;

(c) remove the residents parking place and replace with "at any time" waiting restrictions, shown on the carriageway as double yellow lines, outside:

- (i) Nos. 19 and 21;
- (ii) No. 90; and
- (iii) Nos. 65 and 67.

3. The Orders are necessary to remove certain disabled persons' parking places in Ferndale Road where they are no longer required.
