STOPPING UP OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY – HEADLAM ROAD

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

[NOTE: This Notice is about stopping up a part of the highway of Headlam Road so that it ceases to be public highway and becomes part of the Clapham Park Regeneration development. Objections or other comments may be made – see paragraph 6].

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act"), entitled the London Borough of Lambeth (Stopping-Up of Highways) (Headlam Road) Order 202-.

2. The proposed Order would authorise the stopping-up of an area of the public highway on Headlam Road, which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Clarence Avenue and a point 33 metres south-east of that kerb-line. The area to be stopped-up is shown on the plan attached to the proposed Order (the "relevant plan").

3. If the proposed Order is made, the stopping-up of highway would be authorised only to enable the development described in the Schedule to this Notice to be carried out, in accordance with the planning permission granted on 20th December 2019 under reference 17/03733/FUL.

SCHEDULE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT:

Residential-led, mixed use regeneration of approximately 33 hectares of land at Clapham Park, comprising the demolition of buildings (864 residential units and 614 sq.m of non-residential floorspace) and the construction of new buildings comprising 2,532 new residential units; 2,537 sq.m of non-residential floorspace providing retail floorspace), community facilities including a new community resource centre, and office floorspace; specified accesses and highway improvements (including new accesses on to the local road network and new estate roads.
