## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - ST MATTHEW'S ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable resurfacing and landscaping works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of St Matthew's Road which lies between Hicken Road and the southern kerb-line of the car park which lies adjacent to the northernmost boundary wall of Camsey House. St Matthew's Estate. St Matthew's Road.
- 2 The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. Alternative routes for motor vehicles would not be available as this length of St Matthew's Road is closed to motor vehicles at its junction with Hicken Road.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would have effect from 13<sup>th</sup> March until 14<sup>th</sup> April 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
