TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - UPPER MARSH

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable UK Power Networks service connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily:
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of the south-west to north-east arm of Upper Marsh, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Westminster Bridge Road and the south-western boundary of the railway bridge; and
 - (b) suspend the one way working on the south-west to north-east arm of Upper Marsh between the south-western boundary of the railway bridge and the northern kerb-line of the east to west arm of Upper Marsh.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Royal Street, Centaur Street, Hercules Road, Kennington Road and Westminster Bridge Road.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 13th March 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 13th March 2023 and 17th March 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
