TEMPORARY CLOSURE - BROMELL'S ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable UK Power Networks to undertake repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles (including cyclists) from entering that length of Bromell's Road which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of The Pavement and a point 15 metres north-east of The Pavement.
- 2. Alternative routes would be available for affected motor vehicles via Stonhouse Street and Clapham High Street and vice versa; and for affected cyclists via The Pavement, Clapham High Street and Venn Street and vice versa.
- 3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies the Order that imposes the one-way system in that length of Bromell's Road between the south-western kerb-line of Venn Street and The Pavement would be suspended in so far as that Order bans vehicles proceeding in that length of Bromell's Road from travelling in a direction other than towards The Pavement, to enable access to properties and premises only accessible from this length of Bromell's Road.
- 4 The ban and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 25th April 2023 and continue for 2 months, or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would have effect from 25th April until 2nd May 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 2 months.
