TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - DORSET ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable public realm improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Dorset Road, which lies between the south-eastern boundary of No. 122 Clapham Road and the common boundary of Nos. 151 and 153 Dorset Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would not be required.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 3rd April 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 4 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be take place between 3rd April 2023 and 16th May 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 4 months.
