TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LORN ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable SGN gas main repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Lorn Road which lies between No. 12 Lorn Road and No. 29 Lorn Road.
- 2 The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (a) Stockwell Park Road, Robsart Street and Brixton Road and vice versa; and (b) Brixton Road, Groveway and Stockwell Park Road and vice versa.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 11th April 2023 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 11th and 17th April 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
