## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - SALAMANCA STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Salamanca Street, which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of the service road fronting Nos. 9 to 23 Albert Embankment and Salamanca Place.
- 2. Alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles via (a) Vauxhall Walk, Tinworth Street and Albert Embankment; and (b) Albert Embankment, Black Prince Road and Vauxhall Walk.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would be in force between 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 and 28<sup>th</sup> July 2023 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may also have effect on subsequent days and times within the maximum period of 6 months.
