**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – THORNLAW ROAD & THURLBY ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water supply disconnection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of Thornlaw Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 73 and 75 Thornlaw Road and the common boundary of Nos. 93 and 95 Thornlaw Road;
- (b) ban vehicles from entering that section of Thurlby Road, which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Thornlaw Road and the north-western building wall of No. 89 Thurlby Road; and
- (c) ban any vehicle from waiting, including waiting for the purposes of Loading / unloading, in those sections described above.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Casewick Road, St Julian's Farm Road, Lamberhurst Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
