ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – THORNTON ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunications repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of:

- (i) the Atkins Road Roundabout between the south-westbound lane of Weir Road, north-eastwards to the Atkins Road (eastern arm) westbound lane; and
- (ii) Thornton Road located at its junction with the Atkins Road Roundabout.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Atkins Road, the A205 South Circular Road, Kings Avenue and Thornton Road, and via Thornton Road, Kings Avenue and Atkins Road.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 16th April 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be completed on the 16th April 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 1 month.
