ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – ATLANTIC ROAD FOR SPECIAL EVENT

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable the Brixton BID event to take place, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of Atlantic Road that which lies between the eastern kerb-line of Brixton Road and the northern kerb-line of Coldharbour Lane;
 - (b) all vehicles entering Electric Avenue and Electric Lane are required to exit via the south arm of Electric Lane onto Coldharbour Lane;
 - (c) all vehicles entering the southern arm of Popes Road are required to exit via Brixton Station Road;
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via:-
 - (a) the adjacent roads Brixton Road and Coldharbour Lane and vice versa;
 - (b) buses on diversion will follow the agreed diversion route:-
 - (i) northbound via Railton Road/Atlantic Road, eastward on Coldharbour Lane and northward on Gresham Road, re-joining the bus route at Brixton Road/Stockwell Road;
 - (ii) southbound via Stockwell Park Walk, eastward on St. John's Crescent, southward on Wiltshire Road, south-eastward on Gresham Road, westward on Coldharbour Lane, rejoining the bus route on Railton Road/Atlantic Road.
- 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The ban referred to in paragraph 1(a) above would not apply to emergency vehicles requiring access to properties in that length of Atlantic Road, provided the extent of the said event makes this possible.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 10th June 2023 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 days.
