## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ESTREHAM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Estreham Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 48/49 and Nos. 50/51 Estreham Road and Hambro Road.

2. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (a) Natal Road, Streatham High Road, Mitcham Lane, Ambleside Avenue, Tooting Bec Gardens, Streatham High Road, Greyhound Lane and Estreham Road; and (b) Estreham Road, Greyhound Lane, Streatham High Road and Natal Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2023 for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
