## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS - ST KITTS TERRACE AND BRISTOW ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles:-
  - (a) from entering that length of St Kitts Terrace which lies between Bristow Road and Bridgetown Close (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Bristow Road, Berridge Road, Georgetown Close and Bridgetown Close and vice versa); and
  - (b) proceeding in Bristow Road from entering St Kitts Terrace.
- 2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. The Order would come into force on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2023 for a maximum duration of 6 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
