ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - STERNHOLD AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable a new water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-
 - (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Sternhold Avenue that lies between the south-western kerb-line of Salford Road and the north-eastern kerb-line of Tenham Avenue;
 - (b) ban vehicles from waiting, parking and stopping at any time in that length of Sternhold Avenue which lies on;-
 - (i) the south-west side, between the north-eastern kerb-line of Salford Road and the party wall of Nos. 195/197 and 199/201 Sternhold Avenue;
 - (ii) the north-east side, between the south-western kerb-line of Salford Road and the north-eastern kerb-line of Tenham Avenue.
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via the adjacent roads Salford Road, Criffel Avenue and Tenham Avenue and vice versa.
3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The ban referred to in paragraph 1(a) above would not apply to resident's vehicles or emergency vehicles requiring access to properties in that length of Sternhold Avenue, provided the extent of the said works makes this possible.
5. The Order would come into force on 5 June 2023 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 5 June and 9 June 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months.
