ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - BEEHIVE PLACE AND BRIXTON STATION ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable public realm improvement works to be carried out the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:-

(a) Beehive Place, the whole length;

(b) Brixton Station Road, between Brixton Road and Pope's Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Brixton Road (northbound), Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road (southbound), Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road and Pope's Road; and (ii) Brixton Station Road, Gresham Road and Brixton Road.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 3rd July 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
