ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR

CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING AND PLANNED MAINTENANCE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway resurfacing and planned maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London and Croydon Council, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban all vehicles (including cyclists) from entering, parking or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in the streets and lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice.
- 2. Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply in relation to **(a)** Brixton Station Road, (i) between Popes Road and Gresham Road; and (ii) between Gresham Road and Barrington Road; **(b)** Popes Road; and **(c)** Rozel Road, the Orders that impose the one-way systems and contra-flow cycle lanes in those roads would be suspended.
- 3. Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply in relation to that length of Brixton Station Road which lies between Popes Road and Gresham Road, the order that imposes the banned left turn from Valentia Place into Brixton Station Road would be suspended.
- 4. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph 1 above, via adjacent streets, as indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. The bans and suspensions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 6. The order would come into force on 19th June 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
