ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – COTTAGE GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable safe and compliant working conditions at building sites on Cottage Grove, and for the safety of the public, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, after consulting Transport for London (TfL) intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Cottage Grove between a point 39 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Bedford Road and the western kerb-line of Willington Road and to suspend carriageway and footway parking in Cottage Grove.

- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available:
 - (a) Westbound vehicles via Willington Road, Landor Road, and Bedford Road;
 - (b) Eastbound vehicles via Lendal Terrace, Clapham High Street (A3), Bedford Road, Landor Road, and Willington Road.

3. The ban would apply Monday to Friday between 9am and 5pm or at such other times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. Access to the car park and residents, emergency, and refuse services entering from Willington Road will always remain open. Access to businesses and the car park from Bedford Road will always remain open.

5. The Order would come into force on 10 August 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take 14 months to complete, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 18 months.
