ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - VAUXHALL STREET

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water new water connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:
 - (a) Ban motor vehicles from entering that section of Vauxhall Street, which lies between the southern kerb-line of Kennington Lane and a point 26 metres south of that kerb-line; and
 - (b) suspend the one-way system in Vauxhall Street, between a point 26 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Kennington Lane and the north-western kerb-line of Kennington Oval.
- 2. The cycle lane in that section of Vauxhall Street described in paragraph 1 above would be maintained for the duration of the works.
- 3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Kennington Lane, Durham Street, Harleyford Rad and Kennington Oval.
- 4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 24th July 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 9 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 24th July 2023 and the 6th August 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 9 months.
