ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – HEADLAM ROAD AND THORNCLIFFE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate water main replacement on Kings Avenue, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth and with agreement from Metropolitan Housing, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Headlam Road and Thorncliffe Road which lies between the kerb-line of Kings Avenue and a point 10 metres beyond that kerb-line.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available:
 - (a) Headlam Road closure via Parkfield Road, Fairbourne Road, Allingham Road and vice versa.
 - (b) Thorncliffe Road closure via Kingswood Road and Thornbury Road and vice versa.
- 3. The two roads would not be closed simultaneously. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 4 September 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 4 September 2023 and 22 October 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 12 months.
