

### Dear Resident

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you of the outcome of the Statutory Consultation undertaken in June 2022 on proposals to introduce parking restrictions on your estate.

After careful consideration of the representations received from residents and the recommendations put forward by our officers, the Council has made a decision to proceed with implementing parking restrictions on your estate. ### What happens next?

The implementation works will be undertaken by Ringway Infrastructure Services in partnership with Lambeth Borough Council. The work will be carried out from 8am to 4pm on weekdays (Monday to Friday) and from 8am to 2pm on Saturdays.

### What restriction will be introduced?

We will be introducing double yellow lines and no parking signs. No parking will be permitted on any yellow lines and where applicable in the underground car parks.
