TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - LEIGHAM AVENUE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out a maintenance survey, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Leigham Avenue which lies between No.46 Leigham Avenue and the junction with Conifer Gardens.
- 2. Alternative routes would be available via Woodleigh Gardens, Gracefield Gardens and Conifer Gardens, and vice versa.
- 3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies, the one-way system in Leigham Avenue would be temporarily suspended and a two-way system introduced from the junction with Woodleigh Gardens to No. 46 Leigham Avenue to allow access to and egress from that length of road.
- 4. The bans and suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 28th August 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the said works have been completed, whichever is sooner.
