ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE PALACE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water repairs and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of Palace Road which lies between the junction of Hillside Road and Kingsmead Road.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via: Palace Road, Probyn Road, Lanercost Road, Hillside Road and vice versa.
- 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 5th September 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 5th September 2023 and 7th September 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
