ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ROSENDALE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- ban vehicles from entering that section of Rosendale Road, which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Thurlow Park Road A205 and the common boundary of Nos. 243 and 245 Rosendale Road;
- (b) ban vehicles from entering that section of Turney Road, which lies between the northern kerb-line of Dalkeith Road and the common boundary of Nos. 18 and 20 Turney Road;
- (c) ban vehicles from entering that section of Dalkeith Road, which lies between the eastern kerb-line of Rosendale Road and the eastern boundary of No. 4 Turney Road; and
- (d) ban vehicles from entering that section of Lovelace Road, both arms, which lies between the western kerb-line of Rosendale Road and the common boundary of No. 167 Rosendale Road and No. 2 Lovelace Road.

3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via Croxted Road, Thurlow Park Road, Norwood Road, Christchurch Road, South Circular Road, Tulse Hill, Norwood Road and Rosendale Road.

4. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order would come into force on 21st August 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would take place between 21st August 2023 and the 22nd September 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
